16 EAST BIYS

- Craft #1: Leaf Garland
 - 1. Cut leaf shapes from felt (use templates or freehand).
 - 2. Write names or gratitude messages on each leaf (optional).
 - 3. Glue or clip leaves to string/twine.
 - 4. Let dry, then hang across a mantel or doorway.

- Craft #2: Gratitude Jars
- 1. Decorate jar with ribbon, stickers, or a tag.
- 2. Cut paper strips or use printable gratitude notes.
- 3. Write one thankful thought per strip.
- 4. Fill the jar gradually or daily, then reveal notes weekly in November.

Gratitude.

- Craft #3: Reverse Canvas
- 1. Paint canvas and then cut from frame.
- 2. Cut Styrofoam pumpkin in half and paint.
- 3. Glue pumpkin to canvas backing.
- 4. Add twine, leaves, and cinnamon stick stem.
- 5. Reattach frame and hang your rustic masterpiece.

- Craft #4: Glass Pumpkin
 Decor
- 1. Wrap twine around bowl to create pumpkin "ridges."
- 2. Twist twine and glue on top for the stem and add leaves.
- 3. Add fairy lights or tea light inside for glow.

- **Craft #5: Fall Lanterns**
- 1. Cut napkins to fit jar surface.
- 2. Apply Mod Podge and smooth napkin onto jar.
- 3. Let dry, then add tea light inside.
- 4. Optional: Add cinnamon sticks or dried oranges for scent.

Craft #6: Yarn Pumpkins

- 1. Cut roll into 2" rings.
- 2. Wrap yarn around ring until fully covered.
- 3. Glue twig or cinnamon stick in center as stem.
- 4. Add name tag or string several for a garland.

Craft #7: Cinnamon Stick Candles

- 1. Glue cinnamon sticks vertically around candle.
- 2. Wrap with twine or ribbon.
- 3. Add faux leaves or pinecones for flair.
- 4. Optional: Add a tag for gifting.

Craft #8: Beaded Harvest Corn

- 1. Lay 4 pipe cleaners evenly and twist them together in the center.
- 2. Slide beads on all 8 sides to fill the "kernels" but leave 2 inches on the end.
- 3. Pull all of the non-beaded ends together and twist to form the top husk.

- Craft #9: Paint Pumpkins

 1. Paint pumpkin base color.
- 2. Dip thumb in white paint and press to make ghost shapes.
- 3. Add faces with marker.
- 4. Bonus: Use family thumbprints for a "Ghost Family Pumpkin."

- Craft #10: Pinecone Owl
- 1. Glue eyes and beak to pinecone.
- 2. Add leaves or felt for wings.
- 3. Decorate belly with glitter or paper.
- 4. Add twine loop for ornament or glue to wood slice for place card.
